**THE STATUTE LAWS OF CYPRUS**

**No. 34 OF 1959.**

A LAW TO AMEND THE BANK HOLIDAYS LAW.

**CAP. 45**

*Officer Administering the Government.*

**B**E it enacted by His Excellency the Officer Administering the Government and Commander-in-Chief of the Colony of Cyprus as follows:—

1. This Law may be cited as the Bank Holidays (Amendment Short title. No. 2) Law, 1959, and shall be read as one with the Bank Holidays Law (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Law").

2. Section 5 of the principal Law is hereby repealed and the following substituted therefor :—

“ 5. The following days shall be Bank Holidays—

- (a) Every Sunday.
- (b) The first week-day of January.
- (c) Epiphany day (Greek-Orthodox Church).
- (d) Good Friday (Greek-Orthodox Church).
- (e) Saturday following Good Friday (Greek-Orthodox Church).
- (f) Easter Monday (Greek-Orthodox Church).
- (g) Christmas Day or, if that day be a Sunday, then the following day.
- (h) The twenty-sixth day of December, or, if that day be a Sunday, then the following day, unless Christmas Day falls on a Sunday, in which case the Tuesday following Christmas Day.
- (i) The first Day of Ramazan Bairam.
- (j) The first Day of Qurban Bairam.
- (k) The birthday of the Prophet.
- (l) Independence Day.
- (m) The twenty-fifth day of March.
- (n) The twenty-eighth day of October.
- (o) The twenty-ninth day of October.”
