ORDINANCE 4 OF 1989.

AN ORDINANCE

**TO AMEND THE AKROTIRI VILLAGE (SPECIAL PROVISIONS)
ORDINANCE, 1966.**

BE it enacted by the Administrator of the Sovereign Base Areas of Akrotiri and Dhekelia as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Akrotiri Village (Special Provisions) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1989 and shall be read as one with the Akrotiri Village (Special Provisions) Ordinance, 1966 as amended from time to time (hereinafter referred to as “the principal Ordinance”).

2. Section 2 of the principal Ordinance is hereby amended by deleting the definition of “qualified voter” appearing therein.

3. Section 9 of the principal Ordinance is hereby amended:—

(a) by inserting in paragraph (b) of subsection (1) thereof immediately after the words “who are connected with Akrotiri village by” appearing in the fourth line thereof, the following words and comma:—

“ordinary residence,”; and

(b) by inserting in paragraph (c) of subsection (2) thereof immediately after the words “ceases to be connected with Akrotiri village by” appearing in the first line thereof, the following words and comma:—

“ordinary residence,”; and

- (c) by inserting immediately after subsection (2) thereof the following new subsection to be numbered (2A):—

“(2A) The references to “ordinary residence” in this Section shall for the purpose of this Ordinance mean ordinary residence in fact, and shall not affect in any way any provision of the Control (Entry, Settlement and Commercial Enterprises) Ordinance, 1960 relating to the legality or illegality of residence in the Sovereign Base Areas.”.

- (d) by inserting immediately after subsection (4) thereof the following new subsection to be numbered (5):—

“(5) Every communal owner shall be a qualified voter for the purposes of this Ordinance.”.
