
MOTOR VEHICLES (THIRD PARTY INSURANCE) (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE 2007

An Ordinance to amend the Motor Vehicles (Third Party Insurance) Ordinance 2001.

BE it enacted by the Administrator of the Sovereign Base Areas of Akrotiri and Dhekelia as follows:—

1. Short title

This Ordinance may be cited as the Motor Vehicles (Third Party Insurance) (Amendment) Ordinance 2007.

2. Amendment of section 22 of Motor Vehicles (Third Party Insurance) Ordinance 2001

Section 22 of the the Motor Vehicles (Third Party Insurance) Ordinance 2001(**a**) (limitation of actions) is amended by repealing “two” and substituting “three”.

3. Commencement

This Ordinance comes into force on the day on which it is published in the Gazette.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Ordinance)

1. These explanatory notes relate to the Motor Vehicles (Third Party Insurance) (Amendment) Ordinance 2007 and should be read in conjunction with that Ordinance. They have been prepared by the Office of the Attorney General and Legal Adviser in order to assist the reader of this Ordinance. They do not form part of the Ordinance.
2. This Ordinance makes one amendment to the Motor Vehicles (Third Party Insurance) Ordinance 2001. It extends, from 2 years to 3 years, the limitation period for taking a civil court action under the Ordinance against a tortfeasor (such as the person who caused the road accident for which insurance has been paid out under the Ordinance).
3. The Ordinance is intended broadly to replicate the effect of Republican Law 168(I)/2006.
