## THE CONTAGIOUS DISEASES (ANIMALS) ORDINANCE

(Cap. 45—Laws of Cyprus and Ordinances  
3 of 1969 and 6 of 1969).

ORDER MADE BY THE ADMINISTRATOR  
UNDER SECTION 4(1) (k).

In exercise of the powers vested in the Administrator by Section 4(1)(k) of the Contagious Diseases (Animals) Ordinance, the Acting Administrator hereby makes the following Order :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Contagious Diseases (Animals) (Prohibition of Importation from Lebanon) Order, 1984.

2. The importation or unloading from any ship, aircraft or any other means of conveyance to any port, marina or airport in the Areas and also the passage through the Areas of the following goods consigned from Lebanon is prohibited—

- (a) Animals of any kind as defined in Section 2 of the Ordinance ;
- (b) Animal products, by-products, preparations and other similar things whether processed or not ;
- (c) meat, whether fresh, preserved or chilled.

3. A permit in writing from the Chief Officer is required for imports of agricultural products (beans, seeds etc), animal provisions and any kind of fodder.

4. Animals, animal products, meat, agricultural products, animal provisions and foddors imported unloaded or removed in the Areas in contravention of the provisions of this Order shall be seized and destroyed without any payment of compensation.

5. Goods the importation of which is permitted, shall be disinfected by a public officer as directed by the Chief Officer from time to time.

**THE POWERS AND DUTIES (OFFICERS OF THE  
REPUBLIC OF CYPRUS) (CONSOLIDATION)  
ORDINANCE 1976**

(Ordinance 4 of 1976).

**ORDER MADE BY THE ADMINISTRATOR  
UNDER SECTION 3.**

In exercise of the powers conferred upon the Administrator by Section 3 of the Powers and Duties (Officers of the Republic of Cyprus) (Consolidation) Ordinance, 1976, and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, the Acting Administrator hereby makes the following Order :—

1 This Order may be cited as the Powers and Duties (Officers of the Republic of Cyprus) (Consolidation) (Amendment) Order, 1984 and shall be read as one with the Powers and Duties (Officers of the Republic of Cyprus) (Consolidation) Order, 1976 as amended from time to time (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Order").

**THE CUSTOMS AND EXCISE ORDINANCE**

(Ordinances 12 of 1969, 9 of 1971,  
2 of 1975, 4 of 1977 and 8 of 1977).

DIRECTION BY THE FISCAL OFFICER UNDER SECTION 59(2).

In exercise of the powers vested in him by subsection (2) of Section 59 of the Customs and Excise Ordinance, 1969, the Fiscal Officer hereby directs as follows :—

1. The baggage of every person entering the Sovereign Base Areas by aircraft and any article contained therein or carried with that person shall, unless the Fiscal Officer or other proper officer directs otherwise —

- (a) immediately after unloading, be moved by that person or his agent from the aircraft in the customs airport in which it was imported to the baggage examination hall at due customs airport, and,
- (b) be examined and cleared at the baggage examination hall at the customs airport at which that person enters the Areas.

2. The answers to questions put by the proper officer and the declaration, required by subsections (1) and (2) of Section 59 of the Ordinance, shall be made orally unless the proper officer requires such answers or declaration to be made in writing or otherwise.

3. At Royal Air Force Akrotiri airport where a dual-channel system for the control of incoming passengers and their baggage is functioning, the crossing by the passenger of the customs line on entering the selected channel shall be deemed to be an oral declaration to Customs regarding his baggage and all articles carried with him.
