THE PUBLIC WATERWORKS ORDINANCE

(Cap. 341 — Laws of Cyprus and Ordinances 4 of 1969).

REGULATIONS MADE BY THE ADMINISTRATOR UNDER SECTIONS 4A AND 29.

In exercise of the powers conferred upon the Administrator under Section 4A and 29 of the Public Waterworks Ordinance, the Acting Administrator hereby makes the following Regulations:—

- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Polemidhia (Garyllis) and Yermasoyia Public Waterworks (Regulation and Management) (Amendment) Regulations, 1987 and shall be read as one with the Polemidhia (Garyllis) and Yermasoyia Public Waterworks (Regulation and Management) Regulations, 1976 as amended from time to time (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Regulations").
- 2. The principal Regulations are hereby amended by deleting Regulation 4 thereof and substituting therefor the following new Regulation:—
 - "4. There shall be paid by every proprietor four cents for each cubic metre of water supplied or used by him and obtained from the waterworks.".

THE NARCOTIC DRUGS AND PSYCHOTROPIC SUBSTANCES ORDINANCE. 1980

(Ordinances 13 of 1980 and 7 of 1983).

ORDER UNDER SECTION 3.

In exercise of the powers vested in the Administrator by Section 3 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Ordinance, the Acting Administrator hereby makes the following Order:—

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances (Controlled Drugs) Order, 1987.
 - 2. In this Order —

"Ordinance" means the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Ordinance, 1980 and any Ordinance amending or substituted for the same.

- 3. The First Schedule to the principal Ordinance is hereby amended by adding in paragraph (1) of Part I thereof, the word "Alfentanil" immediately after the word "Acetorphine", the word "DMHP" immediately after the word "Dipipanone", the word "Eticyclidine" immediately after the word "Ethylmethylthiambutene", the words "Parahexyl" and "Pentazocine" immediately after the word "Oxymorphone", the word "Psilocybine" immediately after the word "Properidine", the words "Rolicyclidine", "Sulfentanyl" and "Tenocyclidine" immediately after the word "Racemorphan" and the word "Tilidine" immediately after the word "Thebaine".
- 4. Paragraph (1) of Part II of the First Schedule to the principal Ordinance is hereby amended by adding the word "Dextropropoxyphene" immediately after the word "Dexamphetamine".
- 5. Paragraph (1) of Part III of the First Schedule to the principal Ordinance is hereby amended by adding the word "Mecloqualone" immediately after the word "Clorphentermine" and the word "Phencyclidine" immediately after the word "Pemoline".

THE MINES AND QUARRIES (REGULATION) ORDINANCE

(Cap. 270-Laws of Cyprus-Ordinance 14 of 1963).

REGULATIONS MADE BY THE ADMINISTRATOR UNDER SECTION 47.

In exercise of the powers vested in the Administrator by Section 47 of the Mines and Quarries (Regulation) Ordinance and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, the Acting Administrator hereby makes the following Regulations:—

- P. I. No. 478/58 (Cyprus). P. Is. Nos. 34/64, 64/65 and 90/79.
- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Mines and Quarries (Amendment) Regulations, 1987 and shall be read as one with the Mines and Quarries Regulations, 1958 as amended from time to time (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Regulations").
- 2. The principal Regulations are hereby amended by deleting Regulation 8 thereof and substituting therefor the following new Regulation:—
 - "8.—(1) The expenditure by the holder for prospecting alone shall be as follows:—
 - A. By the holder of prospecting permit Class A—

Provided that the Administrator may, if satisfied that the sum expended by the holder on any area in which he holds such permit is in excess of the aforementioned requirements, allow any such excess or any part thereof to be considered as expended on any other area in respect of which such person holds another prospecting permit, or may be carried forward into the next succeeding six-monthly period of the permit.

- (2) In case after the expiration of a prospecting permit a new prospecting permit is granted to the same holder for the same area or part thereof, the expenditure regarding such area shall be at the rate of £500.00 cents or £100.00 cents in respect of a prospecting permit Class A or a prospecting permit Class B, respectively, for every square kilometre or part thereof for each six-monthly period of the permit."
- 3. Regulation 33 of the principal Regulations is hereby amended by deleting sub-paragraphs (a), (b) and (c) thereof and substituting therefor the following new sub-paragraphs:—
 - "(a) in the case of a mining lease the sum of £500.00;
 - (b) in the case of Class A Quarry Licence the sum of £100.00;
 - (c) in the case of Class B Quarry Licence the sum of £ 25.00;".
- 4. The principal Regulations are hereby amended by deleting the Second Schedule thereto and substituting therefor the following new Second Schedule:—

6. By the licensee of a Quarry Licence Class "A" or "B", a rent of £2.50 cents for every decare or part thereof shall be payable, in addition to the rent specified in paragraphs 4 or 5 of this Schedule, as may in each case be determined by the Chief Officer for the protection of the environment.

A.—Where after the expiration of a prospecting permit a new prospecting permit is granted to the same holder for the same area or part thereof, the rent regarding such area shall be:—

£80.00 cents for a prospecting permit Class "A" or

£40.00 cents for a prospecting permit Class "B"

per square kilometre or part thereof for each six-monthly period of the permit.

B.—Where a new prospecting permit granted as in the preceding paragraph A hereof provided covers, apart from the same area or part thereof, any additional area, the rent regarding such additional area shall be as specified in the preceding paragraph A hereof.

C.—Where any area covered by a quarry licence Class "A" or "B" comprises any Crown land the licensee of such licence shall pay in addition to the rent specified in paragraphs 4, 5 or 6 of this Schedule a rent of $\pounds 4.50$ cents per decare or part thereof:

Provided that the provisions in this paragraph shall not apply where quarry materials from any such Crown land are to be exported out of the Island of Cyprus.
