SUBSIDIARY LEGISLATION

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No. 14**THE COMMODITIES AND SERVICES (REGULATION AND CONTROL) ORDINANCE, 1962.**

(Ordinances 11 of 1962, 9 of 1963, 3 of 1967, 10 of 1972 and 10 of 1982).

CONTROL AND MAXIMUM PRICE ORDER MADE UNDER SECTIONS 3(1) AND 4(1).

In exercise of the powers vested in him by subsection (1) of Sections 3 and 4 of the Commodities and Services (Regulation and Control) Ordinance, the Administrator hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the Commodities and Services (Regulation and Control) (Maximum Price of Portland Cement) Order, 1994 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Order").
2. Portland cement is hereby declared to be a controlled commodity for the purposes of this Ordinance.
3. The retail price at which Portland cement may be sold or offered for sale in the Areas shall not exceed the maximum price set out in the third column of the Schedule thereto.

THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE
(Ordinances 8 of 1973, 5 of 1982, 2 of 1983 and 11 of 1985)

ORDER UNDER SUBSECTION (2) OF SECTION 4

1. This Order may be cited as the Speed Limits (Amendment) Order, 1994 and shall be read as one with the Speed Limits Order, 1989 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Order").

2. Paragraph (3) of Part I of the Schedule to the principal Order, relating to the Limassol-Paphos Road, is hereby amended by inserting under Columns 1 and 2 thereof the following details:-

"On the Curium Beach Road 45 km."

THE COURTS ORDINANCE

(Ordinances 3 of 1960, 7 of 1961, 19 of 1962, 5 of 1963, 3 of 1965,
9 of 1977, 12 of 1984 and 6 of 1988).

RULES OF COURT UNDER SECTION 63.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by Section 63 of the Courts Ordinance, 1960 and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, the Administrator hereby makes the following Rule:-

1. This Rule may be cited as the Civil Procedure (Amendment) (No.1) Rule, 1994 and shall be read as one with the Civil Procedure Rules as amended from time to time (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Rules").

2. Order 26A of the Civil Procedure Rules is hereby revoked.

3. On an application by summons filed by an interested litigant within three months of the promulgation of this Rule the Court may, unconditionally or upon such conditions as it deems proper to impose, set aside the consequences which resulted from the application of the Order which is hereby revoked.

**THE SEA BATHERS (PROTECTION) (CONSOLIDATION)
ORDINANCE, 1986
(Ordinance 4 of 1986).**

ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 3.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by Section 3 of the Sea Bathers (Protection) (Consolidation) Ordinance, 1986 I, the Chief Officer, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the Sea Bathers (Protection) Order, 1994.

2. The areas specified in the Schedule hereto (hereinafter referred to as "reserved areas") are reserved exclusively for persons bathing in the sea, subject to the conditions and restrictions set out in the said Schedule in respect of each area:

Provided that the restrictions relating to the sailing of boats within the reserved areas shall only have effect between sunrise and sunset.

3. The reserved areas shall be demarcated by buoys.

4. This Order shall become operative on the 1st day of May, 1994 and shall cease to have effect on the 31st day of October, 1994.

5. Public Instrument No.16 of 1993 is hereby revoked.

SCHEDULE

AKROTIRI SOVEREIGN BASE AREA

1. All map references in paragraph 2 of this Schedule refer to 1:50,000 scale map, Sheet 23, series K717, edition 3-GSGS.

2. The reserved areas are the territorial waters of the Sovereign Base Areas extending seawards 100 metres unless otherwise stated and marked by buoys, between the following points on the shore:-

(a) **Evdhimou Beach (West).**

77823480 to 77843496:

Provided that motor launches and sailing vessels may enter the said area through a sea-lane 25 metres wide and marked by buoys.

(b) **Evdhimou Beach (East).**

(i) 78253527 to 78603530: and

(ii) 78803528 to 79003522.

(c) **Paramali Beach to Happy Valley Beach Episkopi (West).**

82103567 to 82783591

Except that at the point of the shore at 82433565 the seaward extent of the reserved area shall only be 50 metres.

(d) **Happy Valley Beach Episkopi (West).**

A triangular area between:

82923587, 82943584 and 82983587.

(e) Happy Valley Beach Episkopi (East).

83293581 to 83563590

Except that between the points of the shore at 83543572 and 83563590 the seaward extent of the reserved area shall only be 50 metres.

(f) Tunnel Beach Episkopi.

84383630 to 84653623.

(g) Curium Beach.

88553627 to 89343565:

Provided that motor launches and sailing vessels may enter the said area through two sea lanes each of an approximate width of 50 metres and each marked by buoys.

(h) Ladies Mile Beach.

01103370 to 00682890 extending 100 metres seawards in semicircular loops joined by orange floating rope:

Provided that motor launches and sailing vessels may enter that said area through four sea lanes each of an approximate width of 100 metres and each marked by buoys, and that a fifth sea lane of an approximate width of 150 metres and marked by buoys shall be reserved for sail and wind surf boards only.

3. Royal Air Force Station Akrotiri

(a) All map references in paragraph 3 of this Schedule refer to 1:10000 scale map, Series K912, Sheet Akrotiri and Environs, edition 2-GSGS.

(b) The reserved areas are the territorial waters of the Sovereign Base Areas extending seawards up to 200 metres unless otherwise stated and marked by buoys, between the following points on the shore:

96532528 to 97202560

03022510 to 03222541

02712610 to 02592628

02502660 to 01632737

01542747 to 01402770

01402770 to 01002807

00782833 to 00682890

(c) The seaward extent of the reserved areas will gradually decrease from 200 metres to 100 metres between points:

02502660 to 01632737

then from 100 metres to 50 metres between points:

01542747 to 01402770

then continue at 50 metres to point 01002807 and between points:

00782833 to 00682890

DHEKELIA SOVEREIGN BASE AREA**4. Officers' Club Beach.**

The area of the territorial waters of the Sovereign Base Areas bounded by a line from the headland on the east, under map reference 67887120 of the Dhekelia map, series K912, edition 7-GSGS, to a point westwards under map reference 67457116; thence northwards to a point on the headland under map reference 67457122.

5. CESSAC (Church of England Soldiers', Sailors', Airmen's Club) Beach.

The area of the territorial waters of the Sovereign Base Areas bounded by a line from the headland on the east, under map reference 67187143 of the Dhekelia map, series K912, edition 7-GSGS, then to a point under map reference 67157143 and then to a point southwest under map reference 67067132, then to a point on the coast under map reference 66757129.

6. Dhekelia Jetty.

The area of the territorial waters of the Sovereign Base Areas bounded by a line from the South Eastern extremity of Dhekelia Jetty under map reference 66687103 of Dhekelia map, series K912 edition 7-GSGS, then encompassing the two dolphin structures to a point under map reference 66657099, thence Westward to a point under map reference 66607098 and then to a point on the coast under map reference 66607118.

7. Victor Beach Club (Off Alexander Barracks).

The area of the territorial waters of the Sovereign Base Areas bounded by a line from the shore under map reference 65477129 of the Dhekelia map, series K912, edition 7-GSGS to a point southwards under map reference 65407115; thence westwards in a straight line to a point under map reference 65297115; thence northwards to the shore to a point under map reference 65297128.

8. Fairwinds Beach.

The area of the territorial waters of the Sovereign Base Areas, bounded by a line commencing on the shore at a point under map reference 65287128 of sheet 21 series K717 edition 2-GSGS to a point southwards under map reference 65287115; thence westwards in a straight line, to a point under map reference 64057100; thence northwards to the shore to a point under map reference 64007115, which is found by Boundary Pillar No.1 of the Sovereign Base Area of Dhekelia. Provided that motor launches and sailing vessels may enter through a lane of an approximate width of 15 metres centred on map reference 642711 extending 90° from the shore seawards.

9. Copies of the maps referred to above are properly marked and deposited at the Area Office of the Sovereign Base Areas Administration of Akrotiri and Dhekelia for inspection by any interested person.
