**THE LAND ACQUISITION ORDINANCE**

(Cap.226 - Laws of Cyprus and Ordinances 12 of 1963, 9 of 1964, 1 of 1986, 4 of 1987, 19 of 1988, 10 of 1993 and 1 of 2001).

**NOTICE UNDER SECTION 7**

Whereas by Public Instrument No. 70 of 2005, published in Supplement No.3 of the Gazette No. 1388 of 8<sup>th</sup> August 2005, the Administrator declared the construction of public roads outside the Kolossi agricultural land consolidation area, in the village of Kolossi, within the Sovereign Base Area of Akrotiri, to be an undertaking of public utility;

And whereas the Area Officer Akrotiri, acting in compliance with subsection (1) of section 6 of the Ordinance, by Public Instrument No. 71 of 2005, published in Supplement No.3 of the Gazette No. 1388 of 8<sup>th</sup> August 2005 (hereinafter referred to as “the notice of acquisition”), gave particulars of the private immovable property required in connection with the said undertaking (hereinafter referred to as “the property”);

And whereas the Area Officer Akrotiri, acting in compliance with subsections (2) and (3) of section 6 of the Ordinance has caused to be served, on the person of every interested party, a copy of the notice of acquisition together with a copy of the corresponding entry in the Gazette;

And whereas the Area Officer Akrotiri, acting in compliance with subsection (4) of section 6 of the Ordinance, after the expiration of the relevant period set out in the notice of acquisition, has forwarded to the Administrator the required recommendations, plans or particulars, together with a report that no objection to the intended acquisition of the property had been raised during the said period;

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in him by section 7 of the Ordinance, the Administrator hereby sanctions the acquisition of the property under the provisions of the Ordinance.
