LAND ACQUISITION (SANCTION OF ACQUISITION) (LIMASSOL TO	PAPHOS
MOTORWAY) (No. 2) NOTIFICATION 2011	

In exercise of the powers under section 7 of the Land Acquisition Ordinance(a), the Administrator, having approved the plans and particulars submitted to him under section 6 of that Ordinance and considering it expedient, having had regard to all of the circumstances of the case, that the land referred to in article 2 should be acquired, makes the following notification:

Citation and commencement

1. This notification may be cited as the Land Acquisition (Sanction of Acquisition) (Limassol to Paphos Motorway) (No. 2) Notification 2011 and comes into force on the day it is published in the Gazette.

Sanction of acquisition

2. The acquisition of the private land specified in the Schedule is sanctioned for the construction of part of the Limassol to Paphos motorway, within the Akrotiri Sovereign Base Area.

Schedule

The private immovable property amounting to approximately 560 square metres, comprising part of the combined 6/54ths interest in Plot No. 57 of Sheet/Plan 53/57, in the village of Paramali, and shaded in green on the plan marked "SBA/AK/PA/LPMP/CA/P1" and deposited at the Area Office, Akrotiri.
