**Environmental Assessment of Plans and Programmes Ordinance 2016**

**Ordinance 5/2016**

**Notice under section 19(2)**

1. The Administrator of the Sovereign Base Areas (the “SBAs”) has approved the Policy to Promote Regulation and Control of Development and the Protection of the Environment in the SBAs (the “Policy Statement”).
2. In accordance with sections 19(3) and 19(5) of Ordinance 5/2016, the following information has been recorded in the Register kept in accordance with section 20 of the same Ordinance:
  - a. a description of the Policy Statement as approved;
  - b. a statement summarising—
    - i. how environmental considerations have been integrated into the Policy Statement;
    - ii. how the environmental report and the opinion of the Environment Authority were taken into account;
    - iii. any opinions or representations made during public consultation;
    - iv. the reasons why the Policy Statement, as approved, was chosen, taking into account other reasonable alternatives examined;
  - c. a description of the main negative effects on the environment that will arise or are likely to arise by implementing the Policy Statement; and
  - d. a description of control measures and of how any negative effects caused to the environment by implementing the Policy Statement as approved will be monitored.
3. The register is available for inspection by the public Monday-Friday, during normal working hours, at the offices of the Department of Environment of the Republic of Cyprus at 20-22, 28th Octovriou Street, 2414 Engomi, Nicosia.
